

Attractions

Brittany offers 800 miles of grand rocky coastline, sheltered bays and little fishing villages. The enchanting countryside is dotted with giant granite boulders, wild meadows, moors, and forests.

Steep yourself in the culture of the area by visiting the many megaliths, castles, manor houses, chapels and villages. All of them bear witness to Brittany's eventful history and wealth of traditions.

Josselin Castle

Only 5 minutes drive from the house you will find the small medieval town of Josselin. Take a stroll through cobbled streets lined with 16th and 17th century houses, cafes, restaurants and shops, down to the banks of the Oust River and see the gargoyles of Basilique Notre Dame du Roncier before visiting the historic Josselin chateau.

Dating back to the 11th century, the Chateau's extravagantly-decorated rooms and three stunning formal gardens are open for guided tours, April to September (English language tours take place twice a day).

Each Saturday the streets are filled with the weekly street market where you can buy everything from cheese to chickens.

Lac du Duc

Lac au Duc is a wonderful leisure activity centre, just 10 minutes from the house, where you can experience the countless sporting activities or just relax in the calm of this peaceful and natural environment.

The supervised beaches offer a long list of activities - tennis, volleyball, golfing, angling, walking or rambling, fitness trail, horse riding, safe swimming and even a water slide.

Golf Club

Open all year round, the 9 hole Golf du Lac au Duc is just 15 minutes away, 1km west of Ploermel. Advanced booking is advisable.

Vannes

Just 40 minutes away is southern Brittany's major tourist town, Vannes. Place Henri-IV, in the old town, is a beautiful spot to relax but there are many attractions here including the many restaurants, the Musée de Vannes, Musée d'Archéologie and the aquarium in Parc du Golfe.



Directions

From the Caen or Cherbourg Ferry Ports

From either ferry port head toward Rennes.

Once in the city follow signs for the N24.

Continue along the N24 for 41 1/2 miles then watch for the D169 exit signposted Guillac/La Croix-Helléan.

Turn right at the end of the slip road then immediately left onto the D724 signposted La Croix & St Servat.

Continue straight on the road for 1.1 miles and then turn right onto the D323, signposted for La Croix-Helléan...

From Rennes - Saint-Jacques Airport

Head east toward Avenue Joseph Le Brix, turn right onto D834/Rue Jules Vallès, follow D834 to the roundabout and take the 1st exit onto D34.

Continue along the D34 across 1 roundabout, then take the exit onto the N24.

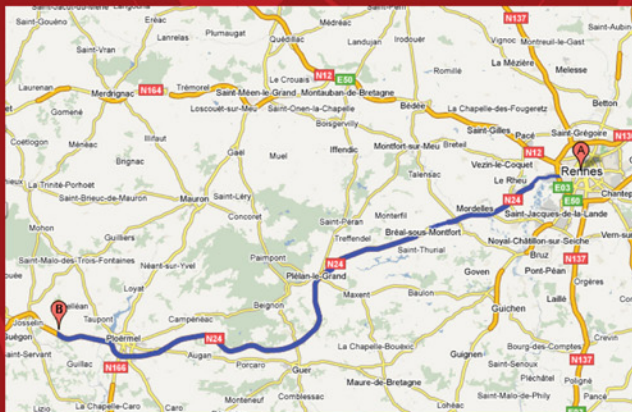
Continue along the N24 for 41 1/2 miles then watch for the D169 exit signposted Guillac/La Croix-Helléan.

Turn right at the end of the slip road then immediately left onto the D724 signposted La Croix & St Servat.

Continue straight on the road for 1.1 miles and then turn right onto the D323, signposted for La Croix-Helléan...

In less than a mile, the house is on the right hand side just before the little crossroads. It stands alone with steps up to the front garden and a large monkey puzzle tree in the garden.

Accommodation

A comfortable four bedroom house situated in a rural setting within 2 miles of Josselin, a lovely medieval town with plenty of history and culture on the banks of the Oust River and only 6 miles from Ploenmel and Lac du Duc with it's variety of hikes, water sports and golf course.

The House

Originally built as a farmhouse and haybarn just after world war II, the house has been extensively renovated and sleeps up to 8 people. Upstairs there is one double bedroom, one twin room, one room with bunk beds and a large bathroom. The second double bedroom is located downstairs with en suite shower-room.

Downstairs you will find the kitchen diner with washing machine, cooker, kettle, coffee maker and a selection of cooking utensils. The house has a full central heating system but in this room you can get comfortable on the sofa and enjoy the rustic warmth of the wood burning fire.

Beyond the kitchen is the salon, a fresh and bright room, with views out over the surrounding green fields. The television in this room has satellite reception with all BBC, ITV channels and Film4. There are also selections of DVDs, books and games for quiet days in and 4 bicycles stored in the basement for days out.
